

8.0 ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCILS, CABINETS AND COMMITTEES

8.1 The Superintendent of Schools may establish such permanent or temporary councils, cabinets and committees as deemed necessary for proper administration of the School District.

8.1.1 All such councils, cabinets and committees shall be advisory in nature and shall exercise no authority or control over the School District or its employees.

8.1.2 The membership composition and responsibilities of such councils, cabinets and committees shall be defined by the Superintendent of Schools and may be revised at his/her discretion.

8.1.3 Expenses incurred by such councils, cabinets and committees shall be paid from the general operating funds of the School District when such expenses are within the budgetary constraints of the School District and are approved by the Superintendent of Schools.

8.2 The Building Principal may establish such permanent or temporary councils, cabinets and committees as deemed necessary for proper administration of the School.

8.2.1 All such councils, cabinets and committees shall be advisory in nature and shall exercise no authority or control over the School or its employees.

8.2.2 The membership composition and responsibilities of such councils, cabinets and committees shall be defined by the Building Principal and may be revised at his/her discretion.

8.2.3 Expenses incurred by such councils, cabinets and committees shall be paid from the general operating funds of the School when such expenses are within the budgetary constraints of the School and are approved by the Building Principal.

8.3 Unless all assigned tasks have been completed, existing committees remain in effect from one year to the next. This is particularly important for continuity when a change in administrative leadership has occurred.
