

## 26.0 HOLIDAYS

26.1 Holidays are Scheduled Non-Work Days for employees and shall be as follows:

26.1.1 Holidays for employees are designated as follows and each will be observed on the day or date indicated. In case any of the below identified holidays fall on Saturday, the Friday preceding shall be considered the holiday; if the holiday falls on a Sunday, the following Monday shall be considered the holiday.

- Independence Day (July 4)
- Labor Day (the first Monday in September)
- Thanksgiving Day (the fourth Thursday in November)
- The Friday following Thanksgiving
- Christmas Eve Day (December 24)
- Christmas Day (December 25th)
- New Year's Eve Day (December 31)
- New Year's Day (January 1<sup>st</sup>)
- Martin Luther King Day (the third Monday in January)
- Presidents' Day (the third Monday in February)
- Memorial Day (the last Monday in May)

26.1.2 Holidays for employees are designated days off in accordance with the district master calendar and indicated on their individual work schedules.
