

2.0 CLASSIFIED STAFF POSITIONS

2.1 All classified positions in the school system shall be established initially by the Board of Education.

2.2 Classified employees, unless otherwise designated by employment agreement or Board of Education policy, shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of Education and shall have only those employment rights expressly established by Board of Education policy. Classified staff members shall be employed for such time as the School District is in need of or desirous of the services of such employees.

2.3 In each case, the Board of Education shall approve a statement of job requirements as presented by the Superintendent of Schools. This shall be in the form of a job description setting forth the qualifications for the job, a detailed list of performance responsibilities and any required physical capabilities.

2.4 Only the Board of Education may abolish a position that it has created.
