

28.0 INSTRUCTION

28.1 The Board of Education expects instructors to utilize “best practice” and research-based instructional strategies and methods to facilitate student learning.

28.2 Strategies and methods shall focus on the assessment of learning needs, differentiating instruction and evaluating progress.

28.3 The Board of Education recognizes that on occasion an instructional method or strategy may be utilized which some parents may find objectionable. Parents are encouraged to discuss their concerns with the classroom teacher.

28.4 Nothing in this policy shall limit a parent/guardian’s right to file a complaint to challenge the use of a teaching method, activity or presentation.
