

21.0 DRUGS, ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO EDUCATION PROGRAM

21.1 The Board of Education is committed to a drugs, alcohol and tobacco education program as an integral part of each student's general education. The substance education program shall provide students with information about nature, effects, and dangers of the use of alcoholic drinks and controlled substances.

21.2 All Board of Education policies, administrative procedures and guidelines concerning the approval of new curriculum and materials shall apply to the drugs, alcohol and tobacco education program of the School District.

21.3 Instructors in drugs, alcohol and tobacco education shall have professional preparation in the subject area, either at the preservice or inservice level.
